## ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The Summer Enrichment Program (SEP) is designed for children with learning disabilities who need help retaining and reinforcing skills in language arts, mathematics and social skills during the summer. Each child will receive individualized enrichment and reinforcement taught in very small groups. Program options include:

- \*1:1 Instruction (one period included in cost of tuition)
- \*Wilson Reading System®
- \*Visualizing & Verbalizing® (V/V®)
- \*Step Up to Writing®
- \*Eureka Math™
- \*other research-based programs

Our 5-week program is designed with academic enrichment in the morning and a recreational program in the afternoon. The afternoon includes swimming, art, drama, music, science, technology and weekly field trips.

## ADMISSIONS

Students do not need to be enrolled in our academic year program. To apply for Summer Program admissions:

1. Schedule a parent interview with the Summer Program Director, Jennifer Gallagher. The interview is designed to share information and to determine whether or not our program meets your child's needs.
2. Submit an application, a recent educational evaluation of your child and a deposit of \$500 by May 1. If TQS determines that our Program will not meet your child's needs, \$400 of the deposit will be refunded. Tuition must be paid in full by June 1 for your child to begin the Program.

Full day students should arrive between 8:00 and 8:15 a.m. and be picked up promptly at 3:15 p.m.

*Parents are responsible for transportation, including setting up school district bus services.*
